The Brazilian Way training program delivers an advanced training methodology with the primary objective of improving the individual's ability to make decisions on the soccer field, so that they will excel at applying the correct technique for any given situation the game presents. As the Brazilian Philosophy dictates, the foundations of the sport are highly emphasized (i.e. dribbling, passing, receiving, finishing, heading, etc) so that they can be applied to game situations with incredible creativity. The program presents the right balance between exercises where players have the opportunity to repeat a technique and small sided games where players have the opportunity to apply the technique in realistic game situations. All in an environment that combines intensity and fun. Ultimately, the Brazilian Way training aims to create a training environment where players learn, develop and understand the game by using their own creativity. Our approach gives individual ownership to the player. Experience has proven that when you give a player ownership of a thought, idea or practical execution of a skill, they are more motivated to carry it through to the end. Thus by guiding their creativity, players can be coerced into making logical decisions, allowing them to remain calmer and at an optimal state to work their way out of trouble. The Brazilian Way is all about developing confidence and instilling passion in the player.

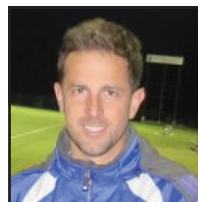

## ABOUT THE DIRECTORS



**Paulo Neto** is a professional soccer coach, having worked in all levels of the sport in America: four different universities in the last fourteen years (NAIA, NCAA-II and NCAA-I); three different semi-professional clubs at PDL and NPSL; Olympic Development

Program at the state and regional levels; and several club teams in four different states. Before coming to the United States, Neto played in the youth system of some of the best clubs in the world including Fluminense FC and SC Corinthians (Brazil). He also played for the U-17 Brazilian National Team. In the USA, Neto was a 3x All-American at Union College. He holds a USSF "A" License, a USSF Youth National License, and a UEFA "A" License. Paulo Neto is currently the club technical director for West Florida Flames, MLS Next and Girls Academy League club affiliate.



**Felipe Lawall** is the Mens Soccer Assistant Coach (2017 - Present) at the University of West Florida (NCAA-II). Lawall played for UWF (2003-06), helping the team to two Gulf South Conference regular-season titles, two GSC Tournament championships

and a spot in the 2006 NCAA Division II Men's Soccer Championship national semifinals. Lawall, a native of Sorocaba, Brazil, was an NSCAA All-America in 2006 and a two-time all-region selection. He earned all-tournament team honors at the 2006 NCAA Division II Championships and in two GSC tournaments. Lawall was inducted to the UWF Hall of Fame in 2015. Lawall holds the NSCAA National Diploma and has been a high school and club coach in Northwest Florida for the past 13 years.
